Registration Fee: \$90

This fee is due at time of enrollment and is non-refundable.

Supply/Activity Fee: (Annual)

This fee is paid once. It covers daily snacks, in-house field trips & art supplies.

1 or 2-day program:	\$100
3-day program:	\$125
4-day program:	\$150

Tuition:

Tuition is calculated for the number of weeks in attendance from September through May. This total cost is then divided equally into nine payments.

1-day program:	\$130
2-day program:	\$230
3-day program:	\$290
4-day program:	\$350

- May 2013 tuition is due on June 10, 2012 and will be deposited on July 1, 2012. ***Refundable only until August 1, 2012.**
- September 2012 tuition is due on September 1, 2012.
- October through April tuition is due the first class day of each month.

After-School Classes:

After-School enrichment classes are held from 2:00-3:00 pm, Tuesday-Thursday. Prices are per 6-week sessions.

Our Philosophy

The WEE Center strives to meet the needs of each child; spiritually, socially, emotionally, physically, and academically. It is our goal to help the children be ready for life, not just Kindergarten, in an environment where children are loved, lives are enriched, and God is glorified.

Our Program

- 18 months - 5 years of age
- 10 am - 2 pm
- Tuesday - Friday
- 1 - 4 days a week

Our Curriculum

The WEE Center provides children with balanced tools for learning and socializing. The WEE Learn Curriculum, published by LifeWay publications, is used as a guide for planning lessons. Utilizing a multi-intelligence approach, teachers provide learning opportunities in the many ways that children learn such as aurally, physically, and visually.

Our Teachers

A teacher and an assistant are in every classroom. All teachers have college degrees or a minimum of five years of experience in early childhood education. All staff members receive extensive annual training in child development and education while working at the WEE Center and are routinely certified in Pediatric First Aid and CPR. All lead teachers are practicing Christians.

Chapel

Our three and four-day classes meet weekly in the sanctuary for chapel while our younger classes meet once a month. Our goal is to help children learn about Christ's love and how God cares for each of us through bible stories and songs.



After-School

After-School classes are offered from 2-3:00 PM, Tuesday through Thursday, for potty-trained children three (3) years of age and older. Class topics rotate throughout the year, giving the children a chance to try new things and to work on skills that will serve them throughout a lifetime of learning.

Music

Students participate in a daily music class where lessons nurture fun through an interactive group experience. Your child will develop physically, emotionally, cognitively, and socially while participating in fun musical activities.



Science

Students explore God's world through meteorology, biology, and physics with hands-on learning experiences that include models and experiments. Lessons are reinforced through tactile learning, movement, music and classroom visits.

Class Size

The WEE Center's classes are intentionally kept small in order to maximize individual attention. The WEE Center exceeds the recommendations of the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) and Virginia's Department of Social Services guidelines regarding student-teacher ratios. The WEE Center's student-teacher ratios are:
