About the WEE Center

As a Christian preschool, the WEE Center strives to meet the needs of each child – spiritually, socially, emotionally, physically, and academically. It is our goal to help the children be ready for life, not just Kindergarten, in an environment where children are loved, lives are enriched, and God is glorified.

Through hands-on activities and play, we encourage a relationship with Christ and a love for learning. The WEE Center provides children with balanced tools for learning and socializing. Each child is encouraged to learn at his or her own pace through a program of activities that include learning centers, outdoor exploration, classroom discovery, independent activities, group activities, pre-reading, math, science, music, in-house field trips, and chapel time.

Curriculum

The WEE Center provides children with balanced tools for learning and socializing. The WEE Learn curriculum, published by LifeWay publications, is used as a guide for planning lessons. Utilizing a multi-intelligence approach, teachers provide learning opportunities in the many ways that children learn such as aurally, physically, and visually.

Teachers

A teacher and an assistant are in every classroom. Our support staff includes an assistant director, science teacher, and a full-time music teacher working with students each week. All teachers have college degrees or a minimum of five years of experience in early childhood education. All staff members receive extensive annual training in child development and education while



working at the WEE Center and are routinely certified in Pediatric First Aid and CPR. All lead teachers are practicing Christians.

Class Size

The WEE Center's classes are intentionally kept small in order to maximize individual attention. The WEE Center exceeds the recommendations of the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) and Virginia's Department of Social Services guidelines regarding student-teacher ratios.
